



## Redmond's Legacy Roofing Continues Rapid Growth with Relocation to New Custom-built Headquarters

***High-quality customer service and home improvement boom fuel Legacy's growth; move will help better serve and expand on existing customer base***

**REDMOND, WASH. – August 6, 2006** –Legacy Roofing, a 18-year old quality roofing installation company serving Seattle and Eastside homeowners, has relocated its Redmond headquarters to 9680 153<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Northeast, off of Willows Road. The move to the newly built 21,000 square foot office building and adjacent work yard comes as a result of Legacy's rapid business growth throughout the past few years, and will enable the company to broaden its customer base area and better serve Puget Sound homeowners. The highly anticipated new space was designed by architect Lance Mueller of Seattle-based Lance Mueller and Associates and built by Seattle-based B. N. Builders, Inc. An official grand opening event will take place in September.

"The move is a true milestone for us," said Cliff Hurn, founder and chief executive officer of Legacy Roofing. "The home improvement industry is really booming right now – in 2005 we completed more than 1,800 projects, up from 1,200 projects the prior year, and are currently averaging about 150 projects a month. In comparison, the company completed roughly 200 total jobs when it was founded in 1988. Amid this growth, Legacy Roofing remains dedicated to exceptional customer care, and the new location enables us to maximize our service offerings while maintaining our signature *Gold Standard™* quality of work on each project."

With the new location comes an immediate expansion of Legacy's services, including a new gutter installation service, which complements its current areas of expertise – roofing and home improvement projects such as decks, siding and window replacements. Last year, the company posted more than \$18 million in revenue through its service, a 35% increase over 2004, which earned them a coveted spot as one of the Puget Sound Business Journal's "Top 100 Fastest Growing Private Companies in Washington" in 2005. In addition, Legacy was honored Remodeling Excellence Award (REX) by The Master Builders Association of King and Snohomish County for an exterior remodel project completed in 2005.

While the company has undergone incredible growth, it still remains committed to community support and contributes to several local organizations and events. Activities this past year included a Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure sponsorship and several team sport sponsorships and scholarships at area High Schools, among other activities.

"Community support has unquestionably been a contributing factor Legacy's success, and it remains very important to us" stated Hurn. "We take great pride in giving back to the community, and with the debut of our new facility, we look forward to even expanding on our involvement moving forward."
